The current NLS staff consists of over 30 seasoned chemists, analysts, technicians, and support staff whose average tenure with the company is more than ten years.

The Location: Crandon, Wisconsin, is situated in the heart of the beautiful Chequamegon-Nicolet National Forest with over 1.5 million acres to explore. The forests, rivers, and lakes offer tremendous outdoor recreational opportunities throughout the seasons. Job Description: This position would be responsible for assembling and shipping sampling kits to clients per specific work orders and for receiving all incoming sample shipments to the laboratory. The receiving process includes screening samples for proper preservation, temperature, and required paperwork. Once receipt screening is complete, all samples are entered into the computer database (LIMS) and placed into proper storage. This position requires the ability to communicate professionally with staff, clients, and couriers regarding scheduling, receipt, and any delivery issues.

Ideal Candidate: The ideal candidate will have a high school diploma with background classes in chemistry, biology, and computer programming. The ability to learn and understand software is a must as sample data entry is crucial. Must be willing to grow within the department and be a team player. Opportunity to build a strong technical background along with contributing to the overall quality, safety, and success of the laboratory.

Requirements: High school diploma. Able to lift a maximum of 50 pounds, push, bend, and handle loading carts and hand trucks. Willing to work as both a part of a team as well as independently at times. Ability to operate within a Windows operating system. Must be willing to relocate for the position.

Compensation: Full-time hourly position with flexible hours. Pay will be dependent on experience. Competitive benefits package including paid time off, sick leave, 401k match, health insurance, and profit sharing is available. After two years of employment, employee stock ownership is available.
