In 1980, NLS moved into a historic old building in beautiful downtown Crandon, WI. More than three decades, three major additions, and a generation later, the modern facility is home to a company that sets the standard for environmental lab services in the Midwest. The current NLS staff consists of over 35 seasoned chemists, analysts, technicians, and support staff whose average tenure with the company is more than ten years.

The Location: Crandon, WI, is situated in the heart of the beautiful Chequamegon-Nicolet National Forest with over 1.5 million acres to explore. The forests, rivers, and lakes offer tremendous outdoor recreational opportunities throughout the seasons. In addition to fantastic recreation, Crandon is a small but strong community with a great school system, festivals, and family-friendly activities.

Job Description: As a member of the NLS Field Services Department, you would be part of a team responsible for the collection of drinking water, wastewater, and groundwater samples at various locations per Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources guidelines. In addition to sample collection, the field technician performs basic sample preparation procedures and basic water chemistries such as filtering, pH, and conductivity. Activities are documented electronically and require basic computer skills. Our field service sites cover the State of Wisconsin and the Upper Peninsula of Michigan. This position will require travel and limited overnight stays.

Ideal Candidate: As an ideal candidate, you will have a minimum of a high school diploma. A background of high school courses in chemistry or biology is a plus. The ability to learn and understand software is necessary. You will be willing to grow within the department by learning the various aspects of the department and be a team player focused on quality and safety. You will have the opportunity to build a strong technical background along with contributing to the overall success and operation of the laboratory.

Requirements: High school diploma. Must be willing to work as both a part of a team as well as independently at times. Must be able to operate within a Windows operating system. Must be willing to relocate for the position. Must be willing to travel and to stay overnight. Must have a valid Wisconsin driver's license. Must be able to lift 50lbs, push, bend, and lift various equipment. Must be able to work outside during all seasons of the year in various weather conditions and on diverse ground and field terrain.

Compensation: This is a full-time hourly position. Pay will be dependent on experience. A competitive benefits package including paid time off, sick leave, 401k match, health insurance, and profit sharing is available. After two years of employment, employee stock ownership is available.
