The current NLS staff consists of over 35 seasoned chemists, analysts, technicians, and support staff whose average tenure with the company is more than ten years.

The Location: Crandon, Wisconsin, is situated in the heart of the beautiful Chequamegon-Nicolet National Forest with over 1.5 million acres to explore. The forests, rivers, and lakes offer tremendous outdoor recreational opportunities throughout the seasons. In addition to fantastic recreation, Crandon is a small but strong community with a great school system, festivals, and family-friendly activities.

Job Description: As a sample control technician, you would be an integral part of the client service/project management team. The sample control technician would fulfill sample kit orders by assembling the kits and shipping them to the assigned clients. In addition, sample kits returned from clients would be properly screened for preservation, temperature, and assigned in the Laboratory Information Management System (LIMS). Other responsibilities include maintaining the inventory of sampling containers, shipping supplies, and adding proper preservation to sampling containers. This position requires the ability to communicate with clients and couriers regarding issues related to the shipping/receiving of sample kits.

Ideal Candidate: As an ideal candidate, you will have a minimum of a high school diploma. A background of high school courses in chemistry or biology is a plus, but is not required. The ability to learn and understand software is a must as the assigning of samples into LIMS is a crucial aspect of the position. You must be willing to grow by learning the various aspects of the department and be a team player focused on quality and safety. You will have the opportunity to build a strong technical background along with contributing to the overall success and operation of the laboratory.

Requirements: A minimum of a high school diploma. Must be willing to work as both a part of a team as well as independently at times. Must be able to operate within a Windows operating system. Must be willing to relocate for the position.

Compensation: This is a full-time hourly position with flexible hours. Pay will be dependent on experience. A competitive benefits package including paid time off, sick leave, 401k match, health insurance, life insurance, and profit sharing is available. After one year of employment, employee stock ownership is available.
